Anyone who is working with children and likely to be part of a Team Around the Child and/or a Lead Professional.

For example:

- Social Workers, Health Visitors, School Nurses, Community Children's Nurses, Paediatricians, Family Partnership Workers, Speech & Language Therapists, CAMHS, CDC staff, Social Work Assistants, Midwives, Children's Disability Workers, GPs, Occupational Therapists, Adult Mental Health and Community Drug & Alcohol Team.
- Head Teachers & Assistant Head Teachers, SENCO's, School Attendance Service, Educational Psychologists and BECO.
- Voluntary and third sector staff who are working with children.
- Police Family Protection Unit, Probation and Prison staff.
- Housing Tenancy Officers/Social Security staff.
