2. Have recognition of the perceived barriers to communicating with disabled children.
3. Understand the impact of values on safeguarding disabled children.
4. Understand indicators of abuse and neglect, including subtle signs across the diverse range of disabilities, and vulnerabilities of disabled children.
5. Have increased knowledge and confidence in seeking support in your role and an awareness of where to get that support.
6. Understand the issues faced by parents of disabled children and be confident to improve partnership with parents.
